

# El Grupo Fall Fondo - Code of Conduct

The Fall Fondo is a ride, not a race. Please be aware that much of the suggested route is open to vehicular and multi-modal traffic. All riders are encouraged to ride at their own pace, and enjoy the ride.

Participants must obey all traffic rules and are responsible for their own safety. In addition, all participants should be aware of their surroundings; including other riders, pedestrians, motor vehicles and equestrians.

Riders **MUST** ride in groups of **NO** more than 10 people at a time! This is being strictly enforced by Pima County and we need your help to make sure this safety precaution is being abided by. El Grupo volunteers will help groups form at the start of the day and upon leaving each SAG stop. **PLEASE HELP US** by making sure that your group obeys all traffic laws (i.e. no more than two abreast) and stays in groups of no more than 10 people throughout the entire ride! Thank you!

Please treat everyone with respect. Give folks a friendly wave or a ring of a bike bell. Be predictable in your riding and communicate with others around you. If passing, adjust your speed if necessary and call out "passing" if you are passing on the left of the rider in front of you.

Lastly, our suggested routes have been designed so that anyone is able to participate. We strongly encourage folks to ride in smaller group sizes between 4 and 8 riders max. Alternate suggested routes can be provided for those riding in larger (yet, no more than 10 please!) and/or fast groups that prioritize bike lanes over multi-use paths.
